


Sp'óqés – Eagle

Do you remember the Xwo:mxelem, the foot runners, and how they brought important messages to the people? Our Elders tell us Eagle is our messenger to Creator.

Did you know that, an Eagle feather has made it all the way to the moon and the International Space Station? Working at the International Space Station can be lonely at times and in 2019 Stó:lō Nation had an opportunity to send


Do you think the astronauts felt loved and cared for when they got the eagle feather? Take some time to think about these questions:
